
RAILFEST, 2003

The theme of the D&SNGRR Railfest was "Happy Rails to you", celebrating the 100th anniversary of the first motion picture "The Great Train Robbery", also inspired by Roy Rogers song "Happy Trails to you". The star of this years picture show however, was Durango & Silverton's locomotive K-27 #473, repainted in it's unique gold, silver and black stripe color scheme nicknamed 'THE BUMBLEBEE' reminiscent of June 18, 1950 when it pulled the Silverton Train. This color scheme was made famous during the 1949 Chicago Railroad Fair when D&RGW painted their C-16 # 268, a coach, four observation Dan Market Silverton Train scheme.

Dan Markoff's Eureka & Palisades #4 was there and must have had a lot of spit and polish, because it looked beautiful. The San Juan Historical Society's Casey Jones made runs from Silverton to the Wye. And our very own Motor #5 ran without a hitch and was sold out or almost sold out on all trips. As was The Eureka and Casey Jones.

Motor #5 carried three generations of Goose devotees. Janet Jennings, as we know affectionately as "Mother Goose", daughter Pam White and two month old Cameron who all had a great Goose ride. Janet's husband Stan was there as official family photographer.

GGHS ANNUAL MEETING, 2003

The annual meeting and open house was held on Saturday September 20th in Flanders Park. Board members present were: President Wayne Brown, Vice President Lew Matis, David Bowyer, Carol Stepe, Bill White, and Marie Richmond. Others that attended were: Tom Garrison, Tom Slayback, Gary & Bill Merrifield, James & Jonathan Bowyer, Hoot Walker and brother Marvin, Sherri Stepe and Lane & Amy Leavell and children. Also present from the Town of Dolores, our Honorable Mayor Marianne Mate.

After approval of the Agenda and Minutes from August, our Vice President Lew Matis, presented the Financial Statement. Denise, our bookkeeper and consultant, was absent from the meeting. It was noted that this is the best financial year to date in the history of the Society. This is due in large part to the proceeds of the gift shop. Almost one thousand dollars came in through the donation jar in the museum from visitors. We are also thankful to three new Life sponsor's this year, namely Carol Stepe, who is on the Society's Board of Director's, Dian Searles and Judy Beck.

Thank you new Life Sponsor's for boosting our membership for the year.

We have also put into place some fund raising projects for track laying this year and have raised \$1.553.76 in track donations, \$1,852.15 from the Return of the RGS videotape and \$432.00 from our Return of the RGS T-shirt. These monies combined opened up two restricted RGS Track certificate of deposit accounts, a 1 Year with a balance of \$2.135.16 and a 4 Year with a balance of \$1,702.75. The 1-Year we will continue to add funds to as they come in on a monthly basis

The Coach #256 restoration restricted savings account stands at \$3,606.19, added to monthly as donations are made. While our Special Projects unrestricted money market account reflects a balance of \$4,197.68. Our checking account as of August 31st reflects a good balance of \$5,772.75, however as pointed out we did have about \$3,800 worth of merchandise purchases payable in the month of September.

RAILFEST

GGHS & D&SNGRR all agreed that Railfest was a huge success and the best ever. Excursion merchandise and concession sales brought in \$3,028.00. Sales in the gift shop also went up that same week of Railfest taking in \$2,213.00. Motor #5 also brought in roughly \$8,000.00 in ticket sales, that will be split with D&SNGRR after D & S expenses are taken out.

TRACK LAYING STATUS

Tom Garrison handed out (An update), Recreating the Rio Grande Southern covering the Objectives, Benefits, Construction Phases, Time Line and other aspects needed to succeed in our future track laying efforts, along with maps of the Lost Canyon right of way. The Town of Dolores have agreed to the 4th Street route. Thank you Tom for an excellent overview. Wayne recently spoke with Lieutenant Ryan Richard of the Colorado National Guard, who expressed his regret that they would not be able to help with track laying any time soon, due to their resources being used up with the situation in Iraq.
